

Spotlight on Stroke

Have you been affected by stroke? The Stroke Association are here to help.

In Halton, we offer high quality information, practical advice and emotional support following a stroke through our Stroke Recovery Service.

We also run two peer support groups for people affected by stroke: our Continuing Support Group, and our drop-in stroke café. These groups give you the opportunity to rediscover previous skills or learn new ones, regain confidence, increase independence and socialise with others who've had similar experiences. Carers, family and friends are also very welcome to join.

The Continuing Support Group offers a range of social activities including talks, crafts and gentle exercise. We meet on alternative Monday afternoons at Murdishaw Community Centre in Runcorn.

Our drop-in stroke cafés meet on the first Wednesday of every month in Widnes at Naughton Fields, Liverpool Road. Join us for a cuppa and a chat and find out about activities happening in the Halton area.

Have you entered our Carers Centre Lottery yet? Halton Carers Centre's Carers Lottery is an opportunity for you to help us raise money for carers and have a chance of winning a cash prize!

All money raised will help us to run the centre which currently supports provides services to over 5000 young & adult carers in Halton.

The more people who enter, the more funds we are able to raise and the bigger the monthly prizes will be! All profits from the lottery will go to Halton Carers Centre, which is a registered Charity. When you join we will write or email you to allocate a number, upon receipt of your monthly payment your number will be entered into our monthly draw which will be drawn on the 20th of the month at 12pm or the nearest Friday, if the 20th falls on a weekend. There will be three prizes. The amount of the prizes will depend on the amount raised that month.

Anyone can join the lottery as long as you are over 16 years of age, you may enter more than once per month at a cost of £5 for the month for each number you are allocated. You can either pay cash, chq or set up a monthly standing order.

As a carer registered with Halton Carers Centre you can access our training courses FREE! If you want to know more about the sessions we have booked in for the upcoming months or to book on please contact the centre:

Mental Health Awareness

2 Sessions - Each session 2hrs long 1 session per week for 2 weeks. 10am - 12 noon.

This session is ideal for those who are supporting someone who has Mental Health, this could be depression, anxiety, eating disorder, OCD, Bipolar etc. It gives you the opportunity to learn more about the diagnosis and meet other carers. At the end of the 2 sessions you will be awarded with a certificate of attendance.

12th & 26th March 30th May & 6th June 5th & 12th September 7th & 14th November



<u>Personality Disorder</u> - 2 Sessions - Each session 2hrs long 1 session per week for 2 weeks. 10am - 12 noon

If you are caring for someone diagnosed with Personality Disorder this session will help you have a better understanding of the condition, coping strategies for you and the person you care for as well meeting other carers. At the end of the 2 sessions you will be awarded with a certificate of attendance.

Other training opportunities we have for carers include:

Basic First Aid Training - This is provided in our Runcorn office by The Red Cross, it covers falls, sprains, cuts, CPR etc. - Friday 8th March, 10am - 12 noon, Halton Carers' Centre.

Start Training - Strategies for relatives caring for someone with dementia/Alzheimer's. Date/Venue to be confirmed.

Caring with Confidence. - Do you feel confident in your caring role, do you feel confident liaising with services about the person you care for? If no or not at times this course is perfect for you!

Halton Home Library Service

Halton Library Service has a Free Home Delivery Service for people who love reading, but are housebound or who find it hard to get to their nearest library for reasons such as mobility problems, illness or old age. The service is also available to people who are carers.

You can receive up to 20 books a month. These can be in normal or large print and audio books are also available.

To book a therapy or podiatry appointment please contact either of our offices during our opening hours. Therapy appointments available include: Massages, facial, pedicures, manicures, waxing, tinting etc. Your first appointment will be free and for any following appointments with our beauty therapist there will be a small charge. Please request a current price list from our offices. For podiatry again your first appointment will be free and any following appointments will be £10 each.

Charges for missed appointments

We require 24 hours' notice for a cancellation so that we can reallocate the appointment. Otherwise, we will charge you for the cost of the appointment. This will be £25.00 for a chiropody appointment and £10 for a therapy appointment. Any carers who do not pay the charge will be unable to access any further treatments.



Halton Carers' Centre Coffee & Support Groups

We have lots of great coffee groups coming up over the next few months, if you want to know about any of our groups please give us a call at either of our offices! All our groups are free to attend and refreshments are provided. Including our Brand new Mental Health Carers Group in Widnes! The group is for any carers caring for someone with any mental illness: schizophrenia, depression, anxiety, bi-polar, OCD, panic disorder, PTSD, dementia etc.

The group will start by having a speaker come along each month and then carers can discuss their caring role and receive ongoing support. This is a really friendly group where confidentiality is adhered to and carers can speak openly about their caring role with one another. Research has proven carer peer support groups can really help as others can understand what you are going through and that you are not alone in your caring role.
